

Admission Procedure Rules and Conditions for Admission for Bachelor Studies in the University Study Programme

Physics at VŠB – Technical University of Ostrava for the academic year 2018/2019

Commencing on 1 January 2018, the Rector of VŠB-TUO officially announces **the first round of the admission procedure** for the academic year **2018/2019** for admission to studies in Bachelor degree programme **Physics** in the following field of study:

- ✚ **Applied physics** in the full-time form of study in the Czech language

At VŠB – Technical University of Ostrava, a tuition fee does not apply to Bachelor degree programmes taught in the Czech language.

To apply for a Bachelor degree programme, a candidate must comply with the following requirements, the deadline for which is 30 April 2018:

- to submit an [electronic application](#). There is no need to print the application, have it confirmed at the secondary school or send it to VŠB-TUO;
- to pay an administration fee of **CZK 500**. The fee is non-refundable at any stage of the admission procedure. It is recommended to pay the administration fee upon the submission of the application form. An application form with an unpaid administration fee will not be further kept in the system.

Should a candidate fail to comply with any of these conditions, his/her application will be removed from the admission process.

The candidate whose application form complies with the conditions for the submission of an application must fulfil the following conditions, the deadline for which is 22 June 2018:

- to send or deliver a certified copy of the school leaving certificate. On the back of the envelope, enter the application number, which can be found in the preview of the electronic application form.
- if education was obtained abroad (except the Slovak Republic), it is necessary to submit a certificate of recognition of a foreign education (http://www.msk.cz/verejna_sprava/postupy.html?n=12).
- the candidate is required to demonstrate his/her ability to study in the chosen language. In the case of studying in the Czech language, it is sufficient to submit a copy of a school-leaving certificate with exams in the Czech or Slovak language; otherwise the candidate must submit a certificate proving his/her knowledge of the Czech language at B2 level (<http://www.vsb.cz/712/cs/cestina-pro-cizince/>).

The candidate for the Bachelor study who has fulfilled the above-mentioned conditions has to pass a written entrance examination in Mathematics if the admission exam is not remitted. The candidate will be accepted if s/he gains at least 5 points out of 48. The admission test takes place on 26 June 2018.

Remission of the entrance examination:

The entrance examination will be remitted for candidates who have passed the secondary school-leaving examination in mathematics or physics, or for those whose average grade in school-leaving examination is to 2.25. The entrance examination will also be remitted for those candidates who have achieved the 50th percentile and above in the national comparative test of general study prerequisites (NSZ), conducted by SCIO (<https://www.scio.cz/nsz>) (it has to be documented by a certificate).

All candidates will be invited to the entrance exam in writing by a registered letter. If the candidate does not appear at the entrance examination without excuse or if his/her apology is not accepted, s/he will not be admitted to the study. If the apology is accepted, the candidate will be notified of an alternative date for the entrance examination. **Those candidates for whom the entrance examination is remitted do not have to appear at the entrance examination.**

At maximum, **40 students** will be admitted to the Bachelor programme **Physics**.

The decision on admission to the degree programmes Physics is made by the Rector of VŠB-TUO. The decision on admission to the Bachelor study must be made in writing within thirty days from the day the requirements for admission were verified, but no later than 26 July 2018. Pursuant to Section 50 Subsection 6 of Act No.111/1998 on Higher Education Institutions, the decision must contain the grounds for the decision, as well as information on the possibility of applying for an appeal, and must be delivered into the candidate's hands. A candidate is entitled to peek into all of his/her materials that have a bearing on his/her admission to studies within 15 days of the receipt of this decision.

Addition for AS – the 2nd round of the admission procedure:

The 2nd round of the admission procedure may be announced **from 1 June 2018 to 15 July 2018**. The expected date for the entrance examination for the 2nd round is 28 August 2018.

Conditions for admission for the university study programmes (fields of study) at VŠB - TU Ostrava for the academic year 2018/2019 were approved by the Academic Senate of VŠB - TU Ostrava on 5 December 2017. The validity of the document is finished by announcing the conditions for admission to the university study programmes for the next academic year.
